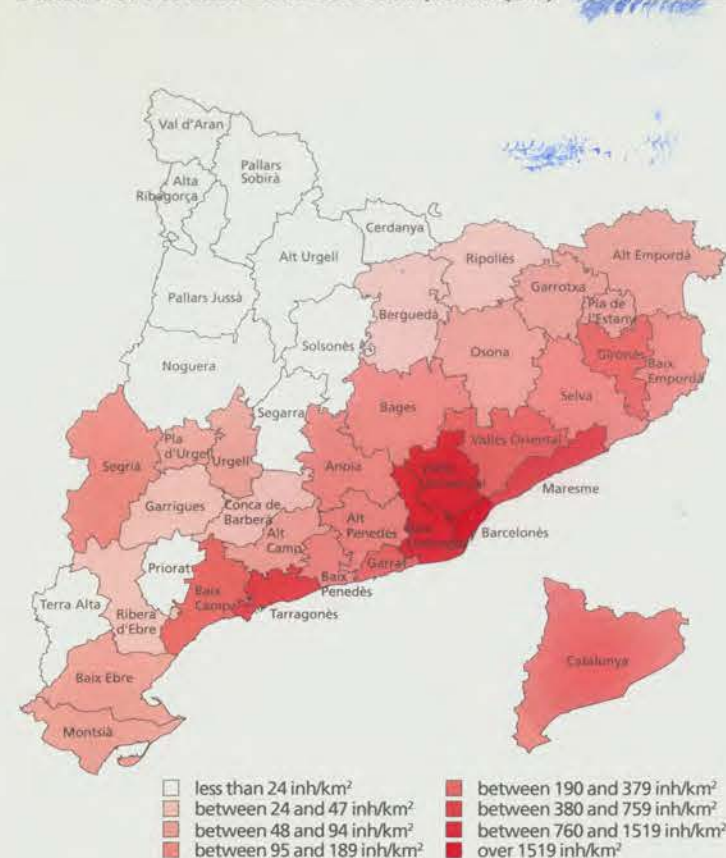

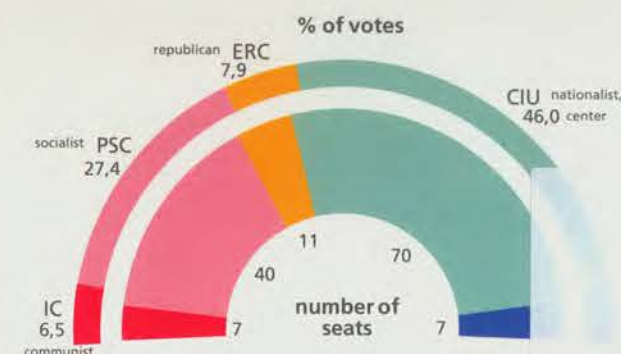
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DENSITY OF POPULATION BY COUNTIES (COMARQUES). 1991

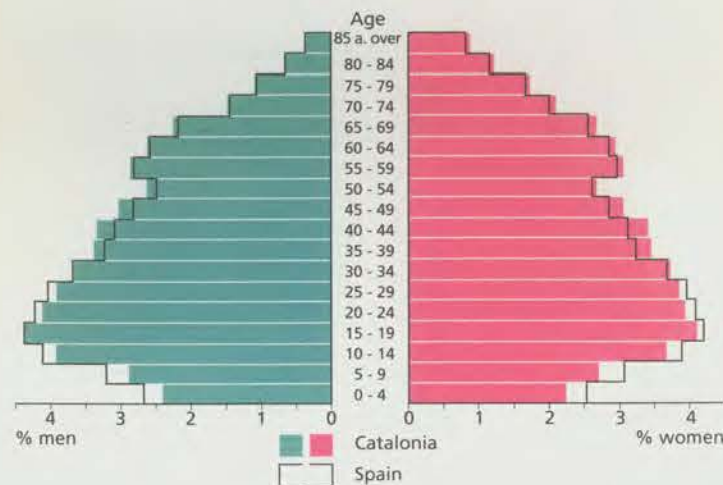

POPULATION AGE DISTRIBUTION. 1991

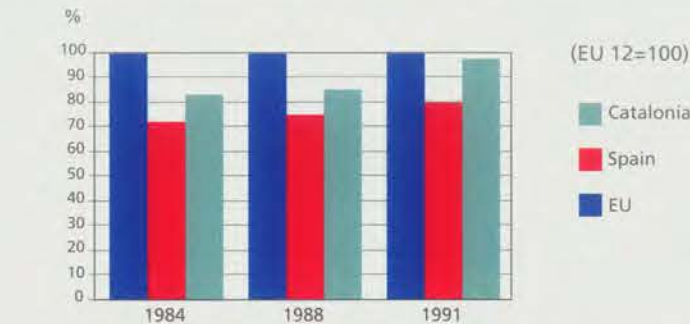

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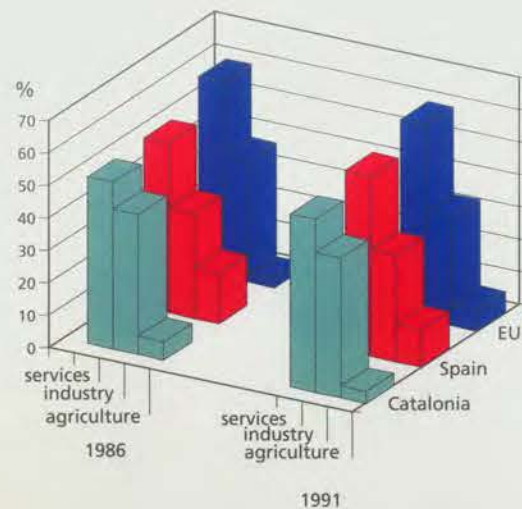
