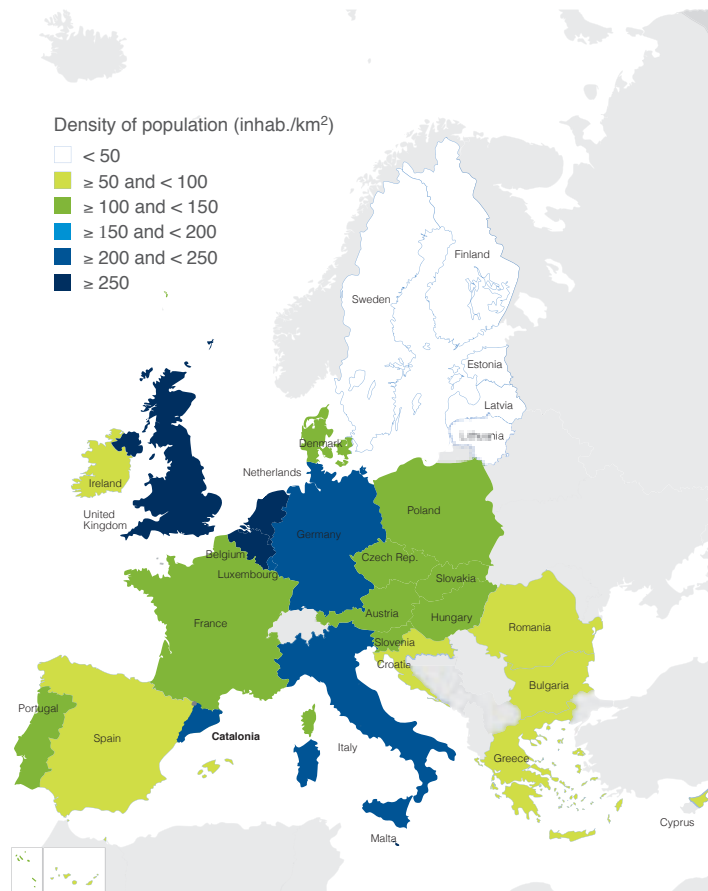
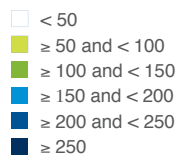

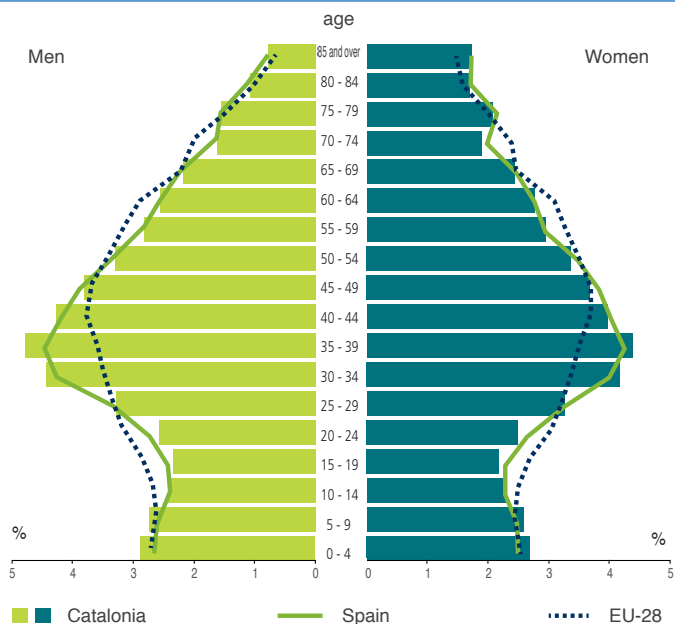

POPULATION STRUCTURE 2012



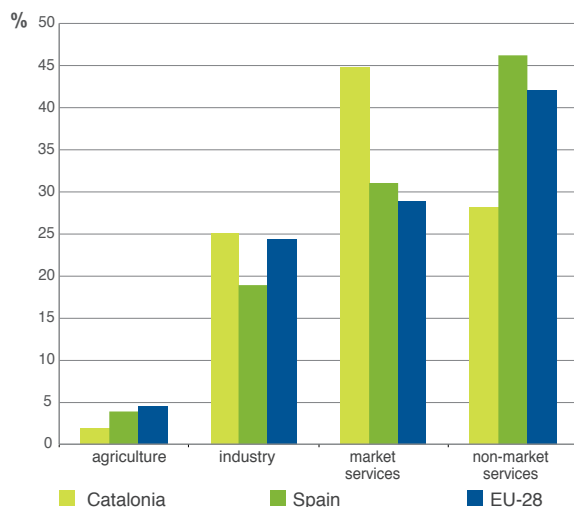

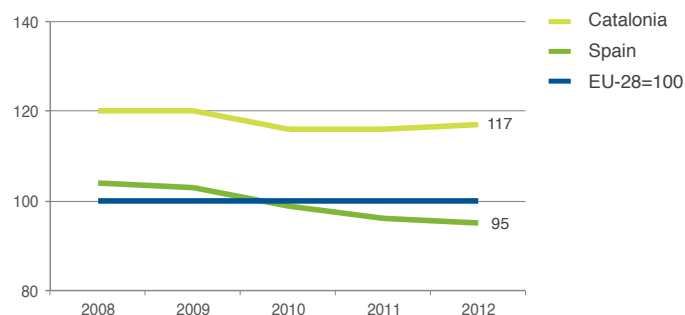
